1. Referring to your letter, O.O. 23377-253, dated January 27, 1906, informing this office that two Luger Pistols, caliber 9 m/m, with 200 cartridges with normal projectiles, and 1,000 cartridges with new double projectiles, would soon be ready for test by the Department, I am instructed by the Chief of Ordnance to send you herewith, under separate cover, for your information a copy of the report of the Board of Officers which tested the material at Springfield Armory.

2. The results of the tests would seem to indicate that the new double bullet does not fly through the air as one projectile.
