Gentlemen:

1. Replying to your letter, O.O. 13092-500, dated March 31, 1906, I am instructed by the Chief of Ordnance to furnish you with the following data pertaining to the arms used in the development of the experimental cal.45 revolver and pistol cartridge, namely:

Length of barrel, 5.8 inches;  
Diameter of bore, .443;  
Six rifling grooves;  
Width of each groove, .193;  
Depth of grooves, .0038;  
Twist of rifling, one turn in 16 inches;  
Width of lands, .94.

2. The above-mentioned data are furnished for such use as you may desire to make of them, but it should be understood that this Department cannot be responsible for any results obtained from their use.
