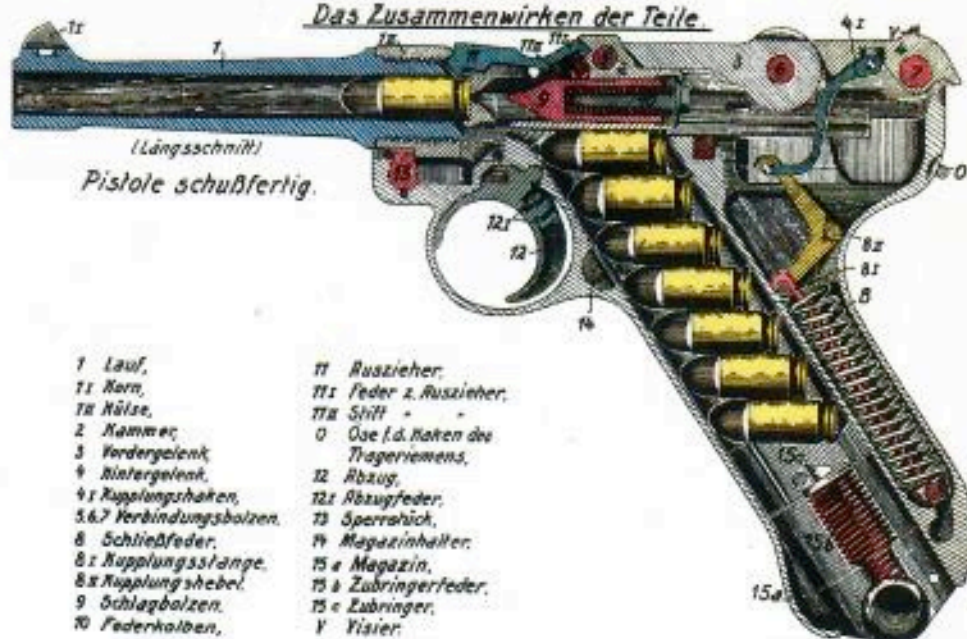

The Mauser Parabellum 1930-1946

Analysis of a Million Luger Pistols



DWM Lugers came in 1930 to Mauser. Where did they go?

Early Mauser Banners went to Portugal, Persia and Switzerland

Military Lugers were produced as from 1934. (K-Dates)

From 1939 toggles were marked with the 42 code for the Army.

Many of the Banners went to German Police units (1938-1942)

The 'byf' code as found on Military pistols from 1941
