The marking (1/R.R.17.112) indicates it was issued the 1st Reiter Regiment of the 1st squadron. There were only 12,000 total Simson Lugers produced in the 1920s and 1930s, with only a small fraction of those receiving regimental unit markings. It's all matching, including the original grips with full four-digit serial present. The bluing is very good overall with most of the wear and patina on the straps. The grips show smoothing and handling wear but no chips or cracks. Bore is shiny with strong rifling and just a bit of freckling. Small parts are all Simson-proofed, including the grip screws. Simson started manufacturing Lugers in 1925 using equipment from the old Erfurt arsenal. Production was very low as the German army was limited in size and equipment following the Treaty of Versailles. Simson & Co. was the only company authorized to produce lugers for the German army during this time but then the company was nationalized by the Nazis in 1933. So total production from 1925 -1933 was very limited - even more rare than the Krieghoff lugers. This gun is all matching and all parts are correctly stamped with the Simson Eagle/6 proof mark. My best guess is that this gun was made in 1931 or 32. The original finish is about 97% with nice straw colored small parts. There is minor muzzle and side plate wear, and a spot of finish loss on the bottom of the front strap. The grips are original as well with the full serial number on the reverse as well as the Simson proof. Even the grip screws are fire blue in color and have the tiny Simson proof.
